## Oregon Smallbore 3 Position State Championships May 24, 2016 | Version 1

**Date:** May 19-20, 2017

**Location:** Oregon State University McAlexander Fieldhouse Indoor Target Range, Corvallis, Oregon. Behind 333 Weniger Hall, Corvallis, Oregon 97331.

**Rules:** It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the rules. The current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules govern this match.

**OSSA Membership:** Oregon residents are only eligible for awards if they are current members of the Oregon State Shooting Association (OSSA). Non-Oregon residents who are current members of their equivalent State Association of residence will be treated as if they are current OSSA members. It is the responsibility of each competitor to provide proof of membership.

**NRA Membership:** Only current members of the National Rifle Association (NRA) are eligible for National Records. Membership to OSSA and to the NRA is encouraged, but neither required.

**Equipment and Ammunition:** Rifles must comply with rule 3.2. The same rifle must be used throughout the match except in the case of a malfunction or disabled rifle, and given permission from the Chief Range Officer (3.1). Metallic Sight and Any Sight categories will be used.

### Matches / Course of fire:

Match 1: 40 shots from the prone position on the A-17 target at 50 feet.

Match 2: 40 shots from the standing position on the A-17 target at 50 feet.

Match 3: 40 shots from the kneeling position on the A-17 target at 50 feet.

Match 4: Grand aggregate of Matches 1, 2, and 3.

Individual match scores will be used for the team match and backing Targets will be used (6.7).

**Teams:** Teams will consist of four shooters. All members of the team must be current OSSA members to be eligible for awards. All members of the team must be current NRA members to be eligible for national records. Pick up teams are ineligible for NRA national records. The team captain must declare all team members prior to any team member firing or the team is ineligible for awards and national records.

### Registration Fees:

Individual shooters: OSSA Members: \$20.00, Non-OSSA Members: \$30.00

Teams per match: \$20.00

**Relays:** Maximum of 14 per relay. Each relay is 3 ½ hours in length.

- Senior, Men's, Women's, Junior, Intermediate-Junior, Sub-Junior, Open, Civilian, and Service High Scores
- Prone, Standing, and Kneeling Match Winners

Points towards State Distinguished Rifleman's Badges will be awarded to current OSSA members who qualify. Trophies and certificates will only be given at the awards ceremony at the conclusion of the match. No awards will be mailed to recipients.

**Awards Ceremony:** Awards will be presented on May 21<sup>st</sup> at 4 pm at the Oregon State University Indoor Shooting Range.

**Coaching:** Prohibited in all of the individual matches (9.10).

**Date:** May 19-21, 2016

**Location:** Oregon State University McAlexander Fieldhouse Indoor Target Range, Corvallis, Oregon. Behind 333 Weniger Hall, Corvallis, Oregon 97331.

**Rules:** It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the rules. The current NRA Precision Air Rifle Position Rules govern the precision air rifle match and the current NRA Sporter Air Rifle Position Rules govern the sporter air rifle match.

**OSSA Membership:** Oregon residents are only eligible for awards if they are current members of the Oregon State Shooting Association (OSSA). Non-Oregon residents who are current members of their equivalent State Association of residence will be treated as if they are current OSSA members. It is the responsibility of each competitor to provide proof of membership.

**NRA Membership:** Only current members of the National Rifle Association (NRA) are eligible for National Records. Membership to OSSA and to the NRA is encouraged, but neither required.

**Equipment and Ammunition:** Rifles must comply with rule 3.2 for Sporter Air Rifle and rule 3.6 for Precision Air Rifle. The same air rifle must be used throughout the match except in the case of a malfunction or disabled rifle, and given permission from the Chief Range Officer (9.1). All clothing must comply with rule 3.11.

**Course of fire:** Precision: 60 shots standing from 10 meters on the AR 5/10 target. Sporter: 40 shots standing from 10 meters on the AR 5/10 target. Individual match scores will be used for the team match and backing Targets will be used (6.7).

**Teams:** Teams will consist of four shooters. All members of the team must be current OSSA members to be eligible for awards. All members of the team must be current NRA members to be eligible for national records. Pick up teams are ineligible for NRA national records. The team captain must declare all team members prior to any team member firing or the team is ineligible for awards and national records.

### Registration Fees:

Teams per match: \$20.00

**Relays:** Maximum of 14 per relay. Each relay is 2 ½ hours in length.
