Targets: NRA Slow Fire (B-6) at 50 yards. NRA Timed and Rapid Fire (B-8), turning targets at 25 yards.

Limit: One relay of 13 competitors per day for the 2700. For the CMP EIC, and NRA Dist. Rev. and Harry Reeves matches, as many relays as necessary each day so all competitors may post scores. Practice matches are not allowed.

Rules: Current NRA Precision Pistol & CMP Rules shall apply.

Classifications: The NRA Classification System will apply. Competitors will be required to show proof of classification, or be subject to an assigned classification by the Statistical Officer.

Minimum Class/Category: There will be no minimum classifications or categories.

Refires: The Alibi Rule will be in effect.

Challenges: A \$10.00 fee will be assessed for all unsuccessful challenges. All challenges will close one hour after the end of Match 19 on Sunday, October 17, 2021.

Teams: All teams will be four shooter teams; pickup teams are not allowed. Four shooter teams must comply with Rules 2.10 - 2.20.

Distinguished Revolver Match: Relays will be fired BOTH days. Current NRA Rules shall apply. Revolvers WILL be checked for compliance with the rules. **DR and CMP shooters may fire on the same relays.**

CMP "Service Pistol" & ".22 Rimfire" Matches: Relays will be fired BOTH Saturday, October 16, and Sunday, October 17, and will begin after the .45 cal. Match #16, or about 3:30 PM. The match will be conducted in accordance with current CMP Rules. **The CMP "Eligibility Affidavit & Liability Agreement," is required to compete.** If Tri-County Gun Club does not have your form on file, then you must present it at time of entry. Per Rule 6.3.3 only the .45 caliber Service Pistol (NRA Rule 3.1); **or the 9mm M-9 U.S. Service Pistol;** or a commercial pistol of the same design and caliber, or other approved Service Pistols per Rule 6.3.4, may be used. All competitors must certify their eligibility by signing the entry and score card. An entry fee of \$15.00 for either the Service Pistol or .22 Rimfire matches must be paid in cash by all competitors.

Ammunition: Per Rule 6.6.2; Service Pistol competitors may use any safe ammunition that is loaded with metal-jacketed bullets. Non-jacketed, wad-cutter or lead bullets may not be used. There is NO VELOCITY REQUIREMENT. .22 Rimfire pistol competitors may use only .22 cal. Rimfire long rifle ammunition with bullets weighing not more than 40 grains. Credit towards distinguished designation will be awarded to civilian competitors by the CMP, following complete review of the Match Bulletin. Military personnel will receive credit, if earned, through their respective Service Headquarters.

CMP, DR, and Harry Reeves shooters may fire on the same relays.

AWARDS: There will be no set award schedule.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: Due to COVID-19, there will be no lunch served. There will be a one hour Lunch Period to allow competitors time to leave the range for lunch, and return.

ENTRIES: **Advance entries are required for reserved positions.** DO NOT send advance payment; but pay at the time of registration.
