

OREGON OFF-HAND CHALLENGE

100 SHOT STANDING HIGH POWER RIFLE TOURNAMENT

- Date: December 14, 2024
- Location: Estacada Rod & Gun Club – 23400 S.E. Eagle Creek Road Eagle Creek, Oregon
- Facilities: Firing will be done from covered points. Heaters will be allowed in the ready area.
- Range Capacity: First 30 competitors. Advance entries given preference.
- Rules: Current NRA High Power Rules shall govern.
- Entries: Entries for this event may be made using a registration card (SR-1) accompanied by check or money order, payable to Estacada Rod & Gun Club or by calling or writing the High Power coordinator, named on the reverse of the program.
- Fees: Individual matches \$ 5.00 each
Package fee \$15.00
Junior package fee \$15.00
- Firing: Will begin at **9:00 am**
- Classification: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches.
- Rifles Allowed: Any centerfire rifle with iron or optic sights.
- Targets: SR - 1
- Scoring: All scoring will be accomplished while targets are still on the target frame. Any shot holes requiring a plug will be plugged at the time of scoring by the chief range officer or his designee.
- Course of Fire: 100 yards on reduced targets

Match 1 - 2 SS Shots and 20 shots for record, standing, Slow fire, SR-1 target Rule # 5.12; time limit 22 minutes

Matches 2-5 20 shots for record, standing, Slow fire, SR-1 Target Rule # 5.12; time limit 20 minutes

Match 6 - Tiny Pratt Perpetual Challenge Trophy, an aggregate of the scores fired in Matches 1-5

Categories in all Matches: Rifles will not be separated into categories for awards. Competitors will be recognized with awards to be given at the completion of firing.

Match Winners and First in Class are not eligible for special awards.

Award Disposition:

1. There must be at least 4 entries in a class for one award, 8 entries for 2 awards.
2. In the event of insufficient entries in any class, the entries will be combined with the next higher class.
3. There must be at least 2 entries in a category for special awards.
4. Masters will not be combined with High Masters should there be insufficient entries.
